Suggested Summer Camp Packing List

Footlocker (around 14" high max) – (Avoid suitcases, large backpacks). Good options are black plastic footlockers sold at Wal-Mart, Dunhams. Or Trader Horn. If you choose to lock your footlocker, please supply the Scoutmaster with the combination or spare key.

Small Backpack (For carrying day to day stuff to other areas of camp, FCA overnighiter, Wilderness Survival overnighiter)

Clothes (enough for 6 nights/days)

- "Class A" Dress uniform – Scout 'Field/Dress' shirt and (if you have them), Scout pants, Scout belt, Scout socks
 - o worn at camp daily for breakfast, dinner & flag ceremonies, worship service, & campfire.
 - o Plastic hanger (for keeping shirt clean and neat).

OA members bring your Sash!

Class B or plain T-Shirts – No logo shirts

Socks

Shorts

At least 1 pair of long pants (especially if taking Swimming or Lifesaving MB)

2 pair shoes

Water shoes for canoeing or showering (No Open Toe Shoes are permitted in camp)*

2 Swimsuits – It's so much nicer to let one dry while wearing the other, especially for mandatory Polar Bear swimming each morning.

Underwear – Use them! Please!

Sweatshirt & Jacket – We camp next to the the water, and it gets chilly sometimes.

PJ's/ Shorts/Sleep Pants

Hat or Cap

Rain Gear (poncho or rain suit)

Toiletries

Soap, deodorant, towel, deodorant, toothbrush, toothpaste, dental floss, deodorant, comb, washcloth, deodorant, shampoo, etc. (Please use them all!)

2 Beach Towels

1 Bathing Towel / Washcloth

Laundry bag (plastic garbage bag ok)

Sleeping

Sleeping Bag and/or Blankets

Prescription Medications – Please make sure instructions are included, and that they are clearly marked with your name.
Flashlight / Extra batteries
Insect Repellant
Sun Screen
Mess Kit - We cook and eat in camp at least once during the week
Hobo Tool/ personal Utensils
Water Bottle
Pencil/Pen
Notebook
Scout Book (keep in gallon Ziploc bag)
Merit badge Books (keep in gallon Ziploc bag)
Cardboard / Foam Pad to cover springs on cots
Rope to tie springs on cots* (Parachute rope would be great for this)

Optional Stuff*

Money for any Merit Badges (Rocketry, Leatherworking, Basketry, etc).
Money for Trading Post. (We suggest only a couple dollars per day please)
Camera*
Compass*
Stamped & Addressed Post Cards*
Personal First Aid Kit*
Knife* – You MUST have your Totin' Chip to possess a knife. No Sheath knives, only small bladed folding knives less than 4".
Frisbee
Playing Cards/Board Game for siesta time

Axes
Hatchets
